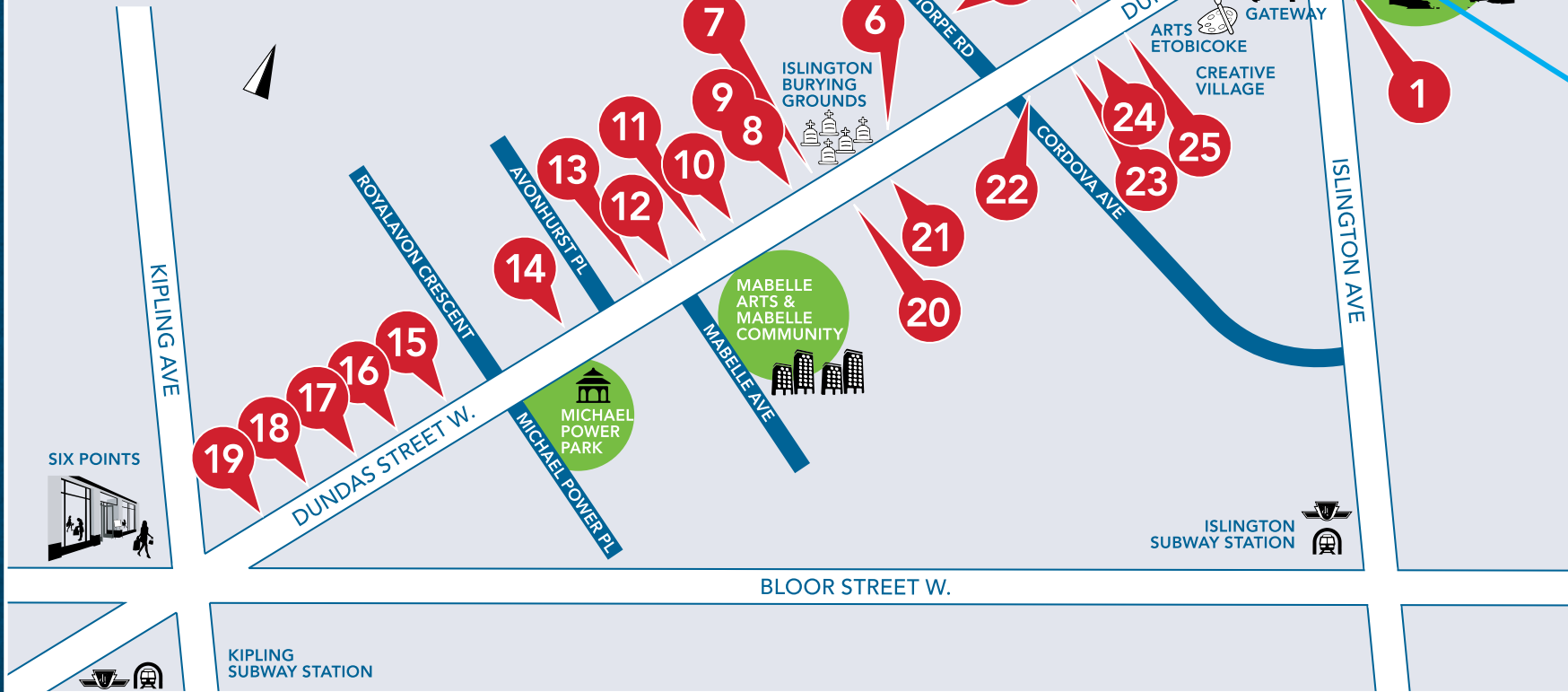




15 minutes to Pearson International Airport

Illustrates the story of an Etobicoke High School student named Harold G. Shipp.



14 Prodigy

Honours Pianist Glenn Gould with his childhood piano teacher, Antonio Alberto Garcia Guerrero ~1947.



15 Fishing in Mimico Creek
John Kuna, 2012 — 5096 Dundas W.
Depicts children in the 1920s fishing in Mimico Creek with animal and plant species once found in the Mimico watershed.



16 Riding the Radials
John Kuna, 2007 — 5110 Dundas W.
Depicts the old Guelph Radial Line which ran behind this property.



17 Toboggan Hill
John Kuna, 2011 — 5112 Dundas W.
Depicts children tobogganing on the hill behind Montgomery's Inn in a fresh snowfall.



18 The Old Swimming Hole
John Kuna, 2009 — 5126 Dundas
Artist's conception of a swimming hole once located on Willow Dale Farm.



19 The Golf Club
2014 — 5134 Dundas W.
Celebrates golf in the area.



20 Timeline: Islington Then and Now
John Kuna, 2006 — 4959 Dundas W.
Shows the south side of Dundas W. at three stages of development.



21 Briarly - Gone but not Forgotten
John Kuna, 2007 — 4937 Dundas W.
Depicts the property known as Briarly, home to the William Montgomery family from 1870-1989.



22 The Faces of Islington
John Kuna, 2013 — 4909 Dundas St. W.
Celebrates the ethnic and cultural character of Islington as it has changed over the last century.



23 Faith of Our Fathers II
John Kuna, 2009 — 4901 Dundas W.
Depicts the history of Islington United Church from its roots as a Wesleyan Methodist Church.



24 The Art Alley Mural Project

The Intersection of Human Rights and Community Art.

Arts Etobicoke, Amnesty International, Creative Village, 2013
Interprets Article 6 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.



2 Welcome Mural
John Kuna, 2011 — On the Mimico Creek Bridge on the north-west corner of Islington Ave. and Dundas W.
Features early residents of Islington.



3 Aftermath
John Kuna, 2011 — 4868 Dundas W.
Depicts the clean-up initiative in the aftermath of Hurricane Hazel.



4 Portraits from the Past
Sara Collard, 2008 — 4884 Dundas W.
Four separate works depict a "slice of life" from Islington's past.



5 Battersby's March
John Kuna, 2012 — 4914 Dundas W.
Commemorates the Bicentennial of the War of 1812 and honours Etobicoke's contribution during this defining conflict.



6 The Pub with No Beer
John Kuna, 2009 — 4946 Dundas W.
Depicts a scene from the prohibition era in Islington (1916-1927).



7 Gordon's Dairy / Islington Seniors' Centre
By John Kuna, 2008 — 4968 Dundas W.
Depicts Gordon's Dairy, a local landmark and since 1960.



8 The Way We Were, Islington ~ 1900
John Kuna, 2005 — 4972 Dundas W.
Shows the village east along Dundas Street from Cordova Avenue in 1912.



9 The Way We Were, Part II ~ 1912
John Kuna, 2006 — 4984 Dundas W.
Shows the old Islington Hotel and drive-shed, Clayton's Butcher shop and neighbouring businesses.



10 Mimico Creek ~ 1920
John Kuna, 2008 — 4986 Dundas W.
Shows Mimico Creek just south of the Dundas Street Bridge facing north ~1920.



11 Honouring Islington's Volunteer Fire Brigade
John Kuna, 2007 — 4988 Dundas W.
A Tribute to Islington's volunteer fire fighters.



12 Ontario Gothic
John Kuna, 2011 — 4990 Dundas W.
Parody of Grant Wood's iconic 1930s painting entitled *American Gothic*.
